 - 1. Turns it possessor away from the right and proper course.
 - 2. A PERVERSE SPIRIT always hinders...never helps.

CONSIDER SOME SPIRITS THAT HINDER

- 1. THE SPIRIT OF FEAR. "Fear is the greatest enemy of man "Hinders progress in any endeavor"
 - 1. Not of "FEAR." "But of Power & Love." 2 Tim. 1:7
 - POVERTY and Want our greatest fear and these because of a lack of faith. Psalms 37:25; Matt. 6:33
 - 3. Isaiah's fearlessness: "Behold God is my salvation;
 I will trust and not be afraid: fpr the Lord Jehovah
 is my strengthmand my song; he also is become my
 salvation. 2. Therefore with joy shall ye draw
 water out of the wells of salvation.
 - 2. THE SPIRIT OF JEALOUSY.
 - 1. The destructive power of Jealousy. Song of Solomon 8:6. "Jealousy is as cruel as the grave, the coals thereof are coals of fire, which hath a most vehement flame."
 - 2. Jealousy the trouble at Corinth. L Cor. 3:1-3;
 Pauls warns them (4:14) Gives them remedy.1:13:1-13
- 3. THE SPIRIT OF SLUMBER. Romans 13:11,12
 1. Inactivity, indolence, iddeness: Habit forming.
