## 1. THE BIBLE WAS GIVEN BY INSPIRATION OF GOD.

- 1. The scBiblere given by inspiration of God. 2Tim.3:16
  - 2. Men moved by the Holy Spirit spake from God.
    2 Peter 1:12-21
  - 3. Moses claimed inspiration from God. Exodus 4:12
- 4. David claimed that "The Spirit of Jehovah spake by me, and his word was upon my tongue." 2 Sam. 23:2
- 5. Christ promised his apostle that the Holy Spirit would guide them into all truth. John 16:13

6. Paul said that He spoke the words that the Holy

  - 1. The invention of printing from movable type in 1454 A. D. by John Gutenberg.
    - 1. Before this the price of a Bible was a year's wages.
    - 2.Gutenberg's first printed book was a Bible. One in Library of Congress at Washington. \$350.000 paid for it.
- 3. THE KING JAMES of 1611. Ordered by King James 1
  3. REASONS WHY THE KING JAMES TRANSLATORS WER NOT INSPIRED.
  - 1. Would not have transliterated BAPTIDZO "baptize" instead of immerse.
  - 2. Would not translated PASCHA "Easter" instead of Passover. Acts 4:12. Would not have belonged to denominations. Sprinkled and poured for immersed
