THE REVERSE PLUNGE

1. In Africa where polygamy, idolatry, adultery and nakedness has been much in evidence in the past:

1. The natives have now turned to (many of them) Monogamy, modesty, and spirituality.

2. All of this because some missionaries introduced them to Jesus: including a great number of our own.

3. This could rightly be called the reverse plunge for they had no way to go but up. They had gone as far down as they could.

THE PLUNGE IN AMERICA

1. Some one has said, according to our good song STAR SPALNGLED BANNER, that America is the "land of the free and the home of the brave."

2. It might be better expressed as the "land of the free and the home of the frustrated."

3. It might be better still to say, "the land of guided missiles and the home of mis-guided men."

4. Some years ago:

1. In America many people started taking their clothes off. This was the real beginning

of the American plunge.

2. There was the plunging neck-line, the strapless evening dress, the strapless bathing suit, and just recently with no straps to bother, the bathing suit plunged all the way to the waist line

5. AMERICAN EDUCATORS ARE SAYING:

1. That American morality has dropped 75 to 80 percent the last sixty years.

2. This could only happen to a people, American or otherwise, where Jesus "is on His way out."

3. Not many Christians are standing up against this trend, but plunging their stand-

ards downward with the world.

4. If up leads to heaven, then down leads to hell. Since America is plunging downward then we find ourselves in real trouble.
