Counsel; Comfort; and relieve, the fatherless and widows, those who need it most in their affliction, in their most hopeless and helpless state; and to keep himself unspotted from the world...from the maxims, tempers, habits and customs of the world. WE MUST REMEMBER:

- 1. That pure and undefiled religion consists principally in faith working by love to God and man. SCRIPTURES: Gal. 5:6; 1 Cor.13:1; 1 John 4:8; 1 John 1:5/
 - 1 Tim. 1:5-7; Three things here mentioned:
 1. Charity or love out of a pure heart. The commandment was not designed to secure merely the outward expressions of love.

3. And of faith unfeigned: Undissembled confidence in God. Can we exercise love
