## 1. PETER'S NEGATIVE INJUNCTIONS TO ELDERS

- 1. NOT OF CONSTRAINT (1 Peter 5:1-3)
  - I. Not by compulsion (forced). Reluctantly, BUT: Willingly, ready to suffer, ready always to do the Lord's will.

#### 2 NOR FOR FILTHY LUCRE

- 1. Not as a means of a livelihood. This shows that elders at one time at least were paid.
- 2. Forbidden to do the work with a view to the pay.
- 3. Elders, preachers, or others who do may part of the Lord's work for pay are unworthy.

# 3. NEITHER AS BEING LORDS OF GOD'S HERITAGE

- 1. If a church member, or a whole church sets out to do something that is not right and the elders object, they may be reminded they are not to "lorditt" over the church.
- 2. On the other hand the elder may take the passage (heb. 13:7) having the word "rule" and put a forced construction upon it. See also: 1Tim.5:17 Heb. 13:17,24.

### 2. DUTIES OF THE ELDERS

- 1. TAKE HEED TO YOURSELVES Acts 20:28
- 2. TAKE HEED (FEED) THE CHURCH OF GOD Acts 20:28
- 3. THEIR DUTIES AND THE HOW OF THEIR DUTIES REVEALED.
  Acts 20:28; Hebrews 13:7. 17, 24; 1 Pet. 5:1-3
- 4. THE PRINCIPLE OF THE LITERAL SHEPHERD IN THE LEADING OF THE SPIRITUAL SHEPHERD.
  - 1. He is to keep the sheep from straying.
  - 2. He is to lead them to water and pasturage by day, and back to the fold, when need be, at night.
  - 3. He is to protect them from all danger by day and by night.
  - 4. He leads the sheep, goes before, by example.
