1-Contrary to the angel's instructions, she had looked behind. Luke 17:32, "Remember Lot's Wife."

2-Lot's wife disabeyed: Thus she brought her tragic fate upon herself.

3-Lot's wife was not deaf to the call; ----She did not think a fanciful phenomena-----She felt the danger and fled. 2-Cor. 6:17; Wherefore

come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean thing; and I will receive you.

3-It is solemnly suggestive: It was doubtless designed to teach many lessons-----

1-The danger of disobediance. 2-The folly of delay.

3-The severity of the Divine judgements....

4-The imtensity of the Divine displeasure against sin.
