1-Since that time the world has been under condemnation.

2-The sin of Adam was a direct disobedience of "positive Divine law."

1-As a result of that sin he became an enemy of God by his own wicked works.

3-The problem before God:

How could the divine law be upheld and the divine

4-The Patriarchal Dispensation: Sacrifice a positive institution;

1-The first sacrifice on record: Genesis 4:3-4:

And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the Lord. (40-And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the Lord had respect unto Abel and to his offering: (5)-But unto Cain and his offering he had not respect.

2-Abel offered his sacrifice by faith: Hebrews 11:4;

By faith Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained withess that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

Romans 10:17; How he got faith;

cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1-The purpose of scarifice: Heb. 9:22.

And almost all things are by the law purged with blood; and without shedding of blood is no remission.

2-Because the sacrifice typifyéddthe shedding of Christ's blood it had to be a lamb with ut spot or blemish: 1-Peter 1:19-20:

But with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot: (20)-Who verily was foreordained before the foundation of the world, but was manifest in these last times for you.

1-Abel's sacrifice represented the shedding of of blood-but cain's sacrifice did not.
