MEN IN MANY DENOMINATIONAL PULPITS TODAY DENY THE VIRGIN BIRTH OF CHRIST AND EVEN THE RESURRECTION OF CHRIST. Such denials are not new among weak feeable faithless little men: Some examples;

- 1. For a group of grown men in Ephesus to yell and scream for two hours (Acts 19:32) "Great is Diana of the Ephesians" did not bringdthe lump of stone in the Ephesian temple to life. Diana remained as dead as she always was: eyes that could not see; ears that could not hear; and a mouth that could not speak.
- 2. For men in Athens to mock at the thought of the resurrection (Acts 17:30-32), and for men in Corinth to say, (1 Cor. 15:12-19), "There is no Resurrection" neither rolled the stone back in place at the resurrection tomb of Christ nor made liars of Peter and Paul who gave their lives to the preaching of the gospel of Christ and in hope of the resurrection from the dead.
