 - a. Death cannot celebrate thee. b. The grave cannot praise thee.
 - c. They that go doen into the pit cannot hope for this truth. Isa. 38:18
- 2. IN THE STORM SOME SAILORS PRAYED. Jonah 1:13-1. The mariners were afraid and every man prayed to his god. Jonah 1:5.
 - 2. Their gods failed so, "they cried unto the Lord."
