- 1. Unprejudiced attention. HEAR ALL THINGS Acts 10:33
- 2. Docile attention. Willing TO HEAR ALL THINGS COMMANDED OF GOD. Acts 10:33
- 3. Practical attention. THEY WERE WILLING TO CONSIDER.
- 4. SUCCESSFUL ATTENTION. Heard, Believed what they heard

Obeyed what they heard.

THOSE INVOLVED IN MEETING

- 1. THE AUDIENCE
 - 1. Though not large, it was a splendid audience. Many (how many) were come together.
 - 2. This audience realized that God was present. (1) We are all here present before God. Acts 10:33
 - 3. This audience made up of those who came for the express purpose fo hear God's word. Not just in part but in entirety. Acts 10:33 (1) Faith cometh by hearing. Rom. 10:17
- 2. THE PREACHER
 - 1. This preacher for the meeting at Caesarea was not a pampered, self-glory seeking preacher.
 - 2. He was not pronounced as: DEEP, COLORFUL, ULTIMATE
 - 3. He had not come to be worshipped: STAND UP, I MY-SELF ALSO AM A MAN. Acts 10:26
 - 4. Peter did not come to reconcile science with revelation. Preach some new doctrine.
 - 3. THE SERMON
 - 1. Peter opened his mouth. Acts 10:34
 - 2. He preached the old gospel of Pentecost.
 - 3. He preached as it might be the last sermon he would ever preach.
 - 4. He made the audience feel that it might be the last sermon they would ever hear.
 - 5. Not a new theology, new creed, HE PREACHED CHRIST
 - 4. THE RESULT OF THE SERMON-MEETING
 - 1. The HolyGhost fell on them which heard. Acts 10:44
 - 2. Can any man forbid water, that these should not be paptied. The contanded them to be paptized. In first Congregation of the bard in Caesarea.
