LOST BY A LOOK Gen. 19:26; Luke 17:32. Sno.9:62

- 1. Lots Wife Lost by Looking Back:
 - 1. Gen. 19:26. She looked back with regret and affection to the place. She met the fate of those who, being often reproved, are suddenly destroyed.
 - 2. So those to whom the gospel is preached have often been warned:
- 1. By every affliction, sermon, death, you have been warned. At last God may say, Proverbs 1:24... "Because I have called and ye refused ... I will not answer. " She was a little to far from Zoar, and too near Sodom.

2. Eve Perished by a Look: Gen. 3:6. And when

- she saw that:
 - 1. The tree was good for food...the lust of the flesh.
 - 2. The tree was pleasant to the eyes...lust of the eyes.
 - 3. The tree was desired to make one wise ... the pride of life. 1 John 2:15.16.
- 3. Many of the Israelites Were Lost by a Look:
 - 1. They were not more than out of Egypt when their hearts turmed back. Exo. 14:10. 1001.10112; Rom. 11,20
- 4. Today the question concerns the present, not the past:
 - 1. Work still to be done; 2 Pet. 1:10.
 - 2. Look not back; <u>Heb. 10:37-39</u>. <u>Phil.3:13</u>
 3. Look to Jesus; Heb. 12:1-3.
