WAS ALL THE WINE DRUNK IN N.T.

It was sometimes preserved unfermented by placing in bottles or jars and burying in earth. This was called a "state of must".

Vine was miggled either to increase or diminish strength.

Jse of wine at Passover not enjoined by Mosaic law, but became custom after Babylonian captivity, when t was mixed with warm water.

PREPARING "MUST": Jar was coated with pitch inside and out, filled with the grapejuice which flowed before being trodden..corked airtight & mmersed in tank of cold water or ouried in sand. Was drunk after 6 weeks to 2 Months, but it was unchanged for a year. This was kept separate from other wines, and was called the "best wine".

Had its place in festivals, marriages, used in drink offerings, was tithed.
