## ENOCH WALKED WITH GOD. Gen. 5:22 How do men walk with God?

1. THEY MUST HAVE SOUGHT AND FOUND RECONCILIATION WITH GOD.

They have come to be agreed with God: Amos 3:3

- 1. Enoch's life of fellowship with God was far from being an acident.
- 2. To be reconciled with God means that one has come to the point where he would let God forgive him.

## 2. MEN WALK WITH GOD BY FAITH. 2 Cor. 5:7

- 1. Faith was the basis for Enoch's success. Not faith alone. Heb. 11:5; See James 2:24, 26
- 2. Faith alone is anything, and the object of faith alone is everything.
- 3. All is explained by faith and by faith we are guided to walk in God's way. (TRUE FAITH ENDEAVORS TO WALK IN GOD'S WAY...DOES NOT TRY TO FORCE GOD TO WALK IN OUR WAY.
- 4. FAITH IS TAKING God at his word. Believing what he said because he said it.

## 3. ENOCH WALKED WITH GOD IN EVIL TIMES. Jude 14

- It Enoch's day, as in any day, walking with God is not easy. <u>Christianity</u> in this day, as in any day, calls for men, real men who would rather be right with the few than to be wrong with the multitude.
- 2. Enoch did not permit the ungodly men of his day who said hard things to him and poked fun at his God to deter him in his walk with God. Enoch knew they were wrong but their wrong did not keep him from walking with God.

## 4. Enoch walkedWITH GOD ... TRANSLATED DID NOT SEE DEATH.

- 1. Enoch came to terms with God on God's terms not his
- 2. Until we come to terms with God we are out of control. have not gained possession of our selves.

- 3. We are not going to be translated as was Enoch unless Jesus comes before we die. 1 Thess. 4:16,17
- 4. What death shall means for us is fixed by all that God means to us.
  - 1. Let any man walk with God, and at the last God will take hims as in the day of Grace he took Jesus, our Brother in Death, our Redeemer from death's sting, and set him at his own right hand in heavenly places.
