II. MORE THAN HONESTY IS REQUIRED.


MATT. 7:21-23. NOT EVERY ONE THAT SAIH UNTO ME, LORD. LORD. SHALL ENTER INTO THE KINGDOM OF HEAVEN: BUT HE THAT DOETH THE WILL OF MY FATHER WHO IS IN HEAVEN. MANY WILL SAY TO ME IN THAT DAY, LORD, LORD, DID WE NOT PROPHESY IN THY NAME AND IN THY NAME CAST OUT DEAMONS AND IN THE NAME DO MANY WON*

A. Not saved by honesty.

B. May be sincere and be lost for not doing will of god.

A. THERE COULD BE NO FALSE PROPHETS.


GAG. 1:8,9 BUT THOUGH WE OR AN ANGEL FROM HEAVEN SHOULD PREACH UNTO YOU ANY GOSPEL OTHER THAN THAT WHICH WE PREACHED UNTO YOU, LET HIM BE ANATHEMA

AS WE HAVE SAID BEFORE, SO SAY I NOW AGAIN, IF ANY MAN PREACHETH UNTO YOU ANY GOSPEL OTHER THAN THAT WHICH YE HAVE RECEIVED, LET HIM BE ANATHEMAN

B. THERE COULD BE NO SUCH THING AS ERROR.

I TIM. 4:1-3 BUT THE SPIRIT SPEAKETH EXPRESSLY THAT INLATER TIMES SOME SHALL FALL AWAY FROM THE FAITH, GIVING HEED TO SEDUCING SPIRITS AND DOCTRINES OF DEMONS, THROUGH THE HYPOGRISY OF MEN THAT SPEAK LIES, BRANDED IN THEIR OWN CONSCIENCE AS WITH A HOT IRON: KE FORBIDDING RO MARRY, AND COMMANDING TO ABSTAIN FROM MEATS, WHOIH GOD CREATED TO BE RECEIVED WITH THANKSGIVING BY THEM THAT BELIEVE AND KNOW THE TRUTH.

C. ERROR WOULD BE AS VALUABLE AS TRUTH II. THESS. II:11.12 AND FOR THIS CAUSE GOD SENDEST THEM A WORKING OF K ERROR, THAT THEY SHOULD BELIEVE A LIE: that they all might be judged who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.



D. NO NEED TO TEACH II TIM. 4:1,2 I CHARGE THEE IN THE SIGHT OF GOD, AND OF CHRIST JESUS, WHO SHALL JUDGE THE LIVING AND THE DEAD, BY HIS APPEARING AND HIS KINGDOM:

PREACH THE WORD; BE URGENT IN SEASON OUT OF SEASON, REPROVE, REBUKE, EXHORT WITH WILL LONGSUFFERING AND TEACHING.

E. SCRIP. NOT NEEDED FOR CORRECTION II TIME. 3:16 EVERY SCRIPTURE INSPIRED OF GOD IS ALSO PROFITABLE FOR TEACHING FOR REPROOF, FOR CORRECTION, FOR INST* RUCTION WHICH IS IN RIGHTEOUSNESS.

A. No need for correction if pagan

teaching is correct.

Reduces Bible to vain bobblings
and meaningless Commands.
