INTRODUCTION: Frequently I notice such statements as: GET

1. God IS INVOLVED.

1. Without God's love we would have to take the gospel out of the meeting, there would be no gospel, no meeting. The gospel is God's GOOD NEWS...the good news of God's redeeming love. John 3:16

2. THE PREACHER IS INVOLVED.

- 1. He is responsible for the preaching of the gospel of Christ in all the world. Mark 16:16
 - 2. He is charged with the responsibility of declaring
 - the "whole counsel of God." Acts 20:27
 3. It is the duty of the preacher, anytime, to faithfully "preach the word." 2 Tim/ 4:1,2
 - 4. He must preach it in kindness, firmly, and as powerfully as he is able.
 - (1) We believe that Jess Hall, Jr., can and will do this very thing.

3. THE CONGREGATION IS INVOLVED.

- 1. No gospel meeting can be a success without the support of the local church.
 - 2. Why expect our neighbors to get excited about something, and attned something that we are not excited about and do not attend ourselves?
 - 3. The member who deliberately refuses to attend service during a gospel meeting, or at any time is sinning before God and all people. James 4:17

4. THE HEARER IS INVOLVED. Luke8:18
